CONDITIONS

WBM welcomes artists and small publishers of art (ists) books to present and sell their art/artist' books which are published between 2007 and 2010. Het Wilde Weten reserves the right to refuse participants due to the character of the proposed titles that we find not suitable enough for this context; books about art and/ or by artists only!
This year, special attention will be paid to the monograph.

Publishers, institutions, etc, that would like to present several titles are expected to run their own stand. These 'book professionals' selling books at WBM will be charged a € 50,- fee to be paid in cash no later than Friday, February 11 at 18.00 hours (a bank transfer is not possible).

Due to the allocation of places it is required to register. Please use the online form, as soon as possible, to guarantee your participation.

The administration of sales for artists selling their books will be managed via a central cash register. Books can be either delivered at HWW in person, or sent by mail. Publishers and institutions will manage their own sales administration. For publications that are printed in an edition: at least 3 copies (but no more than 10 copies) need to be available for sale / to be sent to or delivered at HWW.

10% commission is charged on the sale of all books sold. This will be deducted from the total revenue at the end of the WBM. The revenue from books sold can be collected from HWW in cash, when you collect your unsold copies. As already mentioned: HWW would be very pleased to receive books as a donation for its library.

DELIVERY/SENDING BOOKS

- Together with your books, you submit the delivery form on which the titles, the number of copies, etc, are stated.
- Each book needs to be priced with a sticker or written with pencil.
- For publications in print-run editions: provide at least 3 copies but no more than 10 copies.
- For all the publications please indicate whether you are donating a copy to the HWW library.

- Books will not be sent back, but can only be collected on Sunday, 13 February, immediately after the WBM has closed, and on Monday, 14 February between 12.00 and 15.00.

- Ensure that shipments are received at HWW before 9 February.
- Packages with insufficient postage will not be accepted by HWW.

Please send us an email when you have sent the books so we know they are on their way. When applicable: send us the track and trace number. We will confirm by email upon delivery.

- The swapping of books is the responsibility of the parties involved: HWW will not interfere.
- **Het Wilde Weten is not responsible for theft, damage or disappearance of books.**
